A phrasal verb is made of Particles are "on", "in", "at", "for", "of", "off", "up", etc. The meaning of some phrasal verbs are clear from the verb and the particle like "agree with", "come back", "eat out", or "sit down," , while the others are not. Their meanings should be learnt by heart for example, "give up = stop", "call off = cancel", "make up= invent", etc...
