SUJET N° 1

Crowdfunding websites have caught the imagination of millions of web users, providing businesses and creative ventures with a platform to appeal for money. Projects raise money by asking people to pay in advance for products and services that don't exist yet, using the cash for development. Donors get rewards, often linked to the amount they've promised as a thank you for their support. The rise in crowdfunding has been encouraged by some remarkable successes. The story of how an unknown computer gaming firm reached an ambitious funding target for a new console in eight hours and then went on to raise more than \$8m has become an Internet legend. But for some the bubble has burst. Some entrepreneurs say it's got so competitive, and there are now so many projects that it has become very difficult for small players to get noticed. A rising generation of crowdfunding entrepreneurs seem to be rediscovering a fact of business life: starting a new enterprise is tough.
