Past Participle : - Regular verbs : infinitive + ed
 - Irregular verbs: list (at the end of the book)

Use :
 The past perfect is used when we talk about two completed actions in the past one before another.
 The first action is put in the Past Perfect and the second one in the Past Simple.

Example :
 Last night I watched a movie at 10:00, and then I slept at 11:00
 Last night I had watched a movie before I slept.
